EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. The name "Tokyo Metropolis" is omitted in tables, unless it is necessary to distinguish it from others.
- 2. The data presented in this Yearbook relate mainly to 1959, and the data for other years are shown for the purpose of comparison.
- 3. Generally a calendar year (Jan.~Dec.) is used unless otherwise a fiscal year (Apr.~Mar.) is mentioned. As to the unit of ton, metric ton is adopted in this book.
- 4. The headnotes are general explanations of the table and the footnotes are respectiveexplanations for the items in the table and sources of materials. Every table without source is made up by the Statistics Division, Bureau of General Affairs, Tokyo Metropolitan Government.
